Scripture Memory: Habakkuk 2:4

“Behold, his soul which is lifted up is not upright in him: but the just shall live by his faith.”

What statement is emphasized in Habakkuk 2:4, Romans 1:17, Galatians 3:11, and Hebrews 10:38? Discussion: What does this mean and why does God give such an emphasis to this statement?

God emphasizes in these several verses that the just person shall live by faith.

What is Jesus called in Hebrews 12:2? Discussion: What is a Christian to do if he/she lacks faith? See also Mark 9:19-24

Jesus is called the Author and Finisher of our faith.

The first phrase in Habakkuk 2:4 indicates the Babylonians were filled with pride. How does pride keep us from living by faith?

Answers may vary.

What does God say follows pride and haughtiness in Proverbs 16:18? Why do you believe this happens?

Pride *goeth* before destruction, and an haughty spirit before a fall.

What description of faith do we find in Hebrews 11:1? Discussion: Why is faith so important to what Jesus calls a “faithless generation”?

Faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

What expression do we find in the beginning of Hebrews 12:2 that gives the definition of faith? Why is this a good definition?

Looking unto Jesus.

According to I John 5:4, what is the result of living by faith? Discussion: If this is true, how can we see deficiencies in our faith?

The result of living by faith is victory that overcomes the world.
