Scripture Memory: Habakkuk 3:16

"When I heard, my belly trembled; my lips quivered at the voice: rottenness entered into my bones, and I trembled in myself, that I might rest in the day of trouble."

Read Habakkuk 3:3. Who came on the scene to meet Habakkuk's need? Discussion: Why is this important for us to know and trust as a promise for us?

According to Habakkuk 3:16, what happened to Habakkuk when He heard from the Lord? Discussion: Why do we find ourselves feeling the same way?

According to Habakkuk 3:16, what did Habakkuk desire "in the day of trouble"? Discussion: Why is rest important when we are in the midst of fear?

Habakkuk desired that God would give him rest in the day of trouble.

According to Isaiah 46:9, what are we supposed to remember? Why does the fear of God lead us to remember this truth?

We are to remember that God alone is God and no one else.
