**Scripture Memory: Habakkuk 3:2**

“O Lord, I have heard thy speech, and was afraid: O Lord revive thy work in the midst of the years,  
in the midst of the years make known; in wrath remember mercy.”

**Read Habakkuk 3:2 and Mark 16:15. What is the difference between evangelism and revival? Discussion: Is evangelism what is needed for revival or what happens when revival comes?**

*Revival comes to a believer from God. Evangelism is the believer preaching the gospel to every creature.*

**According to Philippians 1:6, what is the work of God? Discussion: When God revives the Christian what changes take place?**

God’s work is His work in the believer.

**According to Habakkuk 3:1, when the prophet was burdened for revival what did He do? Why will prayer be the initial step of revival?**

The word Shigionoth means an expression of strong emotion. Habakkuk, because he knew the deepness of the need and because it brought him great emotion, prayed.

**In Habakkuk 3:2, what was Habakkuk’s reaction when he heard the Lord speak? Should this be our response when we hear the Lord speak?**

Habakkuk heard the Lord speak and was afraid.

**In Romans 3:18, how does God's Word describe those who do not know Him? Discussion: Why is this foolishness and what should the unsaved do?**

*God says that the unsaved have no fear of God.*

**In Habakkuk 3:2, the prophet prayed for God to remember what? Why was this his only hope?**

*Habakkuk asked the Lord to remember mercy.*
