**The Question All People Ask And No One Answer**

**Scripture Memory: Habakkuk 1:3**

“Why dost thou shew me iniquity, and cause me to behold grievance? For spoiling and violence are before me: and there are that raise up strife and contention.”

**The question all people ask and no one can answer is the first word of Habakkuk 1:3. What is it? Who is able to answer this question? Discussion: Why is it important to be willing to ask this question?**

**What does the psalmist say in Psalm 12:8 about his surroundings? Does this truth remove God’s love for us? What promises can we look to when considering this situation?**

*“The wicked walk on every side, when the vilest men are exalted.”*

**What has God done to show his love for the world according to John 3:16? Why is it important to remember this?**

*God sent His only begotten so to show that he loves us.*

**What does II Peter 3:8 tell us about God's timetable? How is this a comfort to us?**

**What does II Corinthians 5:7 teach us about the Christian walk? Why do we not need every question answered?**

*The Christian walk is the walk of faith.*

**According to I John 5:4, how do we live in victory? How is this important to our day to day lives?**
